HOW TO REINFORCE THE THEME

Free play: lay out ocean water (blue blanket or paper) and build with legos or blocks, play with ocean animal toys in the bathtub

Math and Science : Make two sets of cutout fish with numbers 1-5 and play memory with them, make homemade playdoh and make ocean animals, see what things sink or float in the bathtub

Outdoor time : Hide ocean toys outside and let them find them, draw the outlines of the Rainbow Fish and ocean animals using sidewalk chalk and let children color it in, play tag where the person who is it is a shark
